## 2021 Wreath Contest Information

### Categories:

Category 1: business, non-profit, or adult

Category 2: youth (individuals 17 years and under; or a classroom group)

### Rules and Contest Information

1. Only one entry per individual, entity, or classroom group. There is no entry fee.
2. All entries will be showcased at the Madrone School, 4<sup>th</sup> Annual Gala—Seasons of Change, on Saturday, October 9<sup>th</sup>, 2021.
3. Entrant is responsible for all costs associated with buying supplies to make and decorate the Wreath.
4. All entries will be donated, by Entrant, to be included in the Gala, online, silent auction catalog. All proceeds from wreath sales go to the Madrone School.
5. Wreath design considerations:
  - Should be decorated by the PERSON or GROUP submitting the entry.
  - The design should be appropriate for all age groups and is not limited in theme.
  - Should be labeled to specify if it is for indoor or outdoor display.
  - Can be any size up to 28 inches in diameter.
  - Can use any wreath form (foam, wire, faux greenery, straw, etc.).
  - Should not include fresh cut evergreen or plant material. Dried floral and greenery is okay. We would like winners of the Wreaths to enjoy these for the long haul.
  - Decorations must be securely attached to the wreath, not sit, or be placed alongside the wreath. Decorations may hang from the wreath, be tied to the wreath, or be securely glued to the wreath. If a decoration falls off, it will not be replaced on the wreath.
  - Should not require electrical outlet to operate. Battery operated components are okay.
6. Entries will be voted on using the Gala website voting contest functionality. The contest will open at a pre-determined time and close during the Gala. The winning entry for each category will be determined by highest total votes at contest close.
7. Entrants can gain inspiration from Etsy, Google, Pinterest, or another source. Our number one goal is to get people having FUN and CREATIVE in a contribution to the Gala.
